

GMS WSQ: Supervise Quality Procedures (MF-COM-301C-1)

Introduction

This course is developed to enable participants to create the awareness of the skills and knowledge in supervising quality control teams at the work place. It is a systematic approach that they can use to make incremental and breakthrough improvements in processes and services for customers.

Course Objective

Upon completion of this course, participants will have the knowledge and application skills in participating and supervising quality processes and will be able to apply them to the workplace.

These skills include:

- Supervising and monitoring quality control systems internal as well as external
- Reviewing processes for improving quality
- Developing and maintaining quality control record systems

**SMEs are defined as companies with:*

(i) at least 30% local shareholding; AND

(ii) Group annual sales turnover of not more than \$100 million OR Group employment size of not more than 200 employees.

Workfare Training Support (WTS) Scheme:

Singapore citizens aged ≥ 35 years & earning ≤ \$2,000/ month are eligible for 95% course fee subsidy. Companies can also apply for absentee payroll at 95% of hourly basic salary.

Funding Eligibility

In order to enjoy the funding, participants need to fulfill the following requirements:

1. Singapore Citizens or Permanent Residents (PR) of Singapore
2. Attain at least 75% course attendance
3. Successfully complete assessment and certified as competent
4. Participant has not enjoyed funding for the same course before

*For company-sponsored participants, training must be fully sponsored by companies, which are registered or incorporated in Singapore
