

AMENDMENTS TO THE PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION ACT (Online via ZOOM)

Course Introduction

Following a public consultation conducted by the Ministry of Communications and Information (MCI) and the Personal Data Protection Commission (PDPC) on the draft Personal Data Protection (Amendment) Bill from 14 to 28 May 2020, the proposed **amendments to the Singapore Personal Data Protection Act (PDPA) were introduced in the Singapore Parliament by the Minister for Communications and Information on 5 October 2020.** This has an **impact to employers and employee in the organisations.** Penalties and jail terms are part of the deterrence measures put in place as well.
